Luke 18:25 says "It is easier for a camel to walk through the eye of a needle than for someone who is rich to enter the kingdom of God." We all know the one church lady who will quote this verse because she thinks rich people shouldn't have financial success. (So we should all strive to be poor???) Here's something to chew on...almost every American family has an income that puts them squarely in the top 1% of the world's wealth. 
