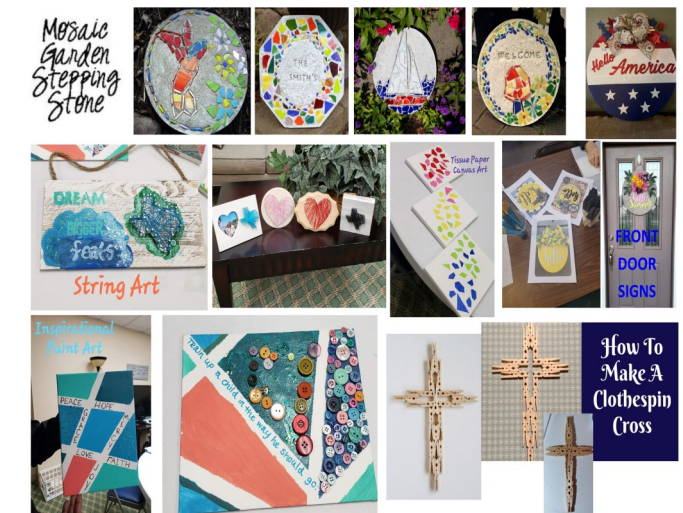
This event will feature God's grace: Prevenient Grace, Justifying Grace, and Sanctifying Grace
