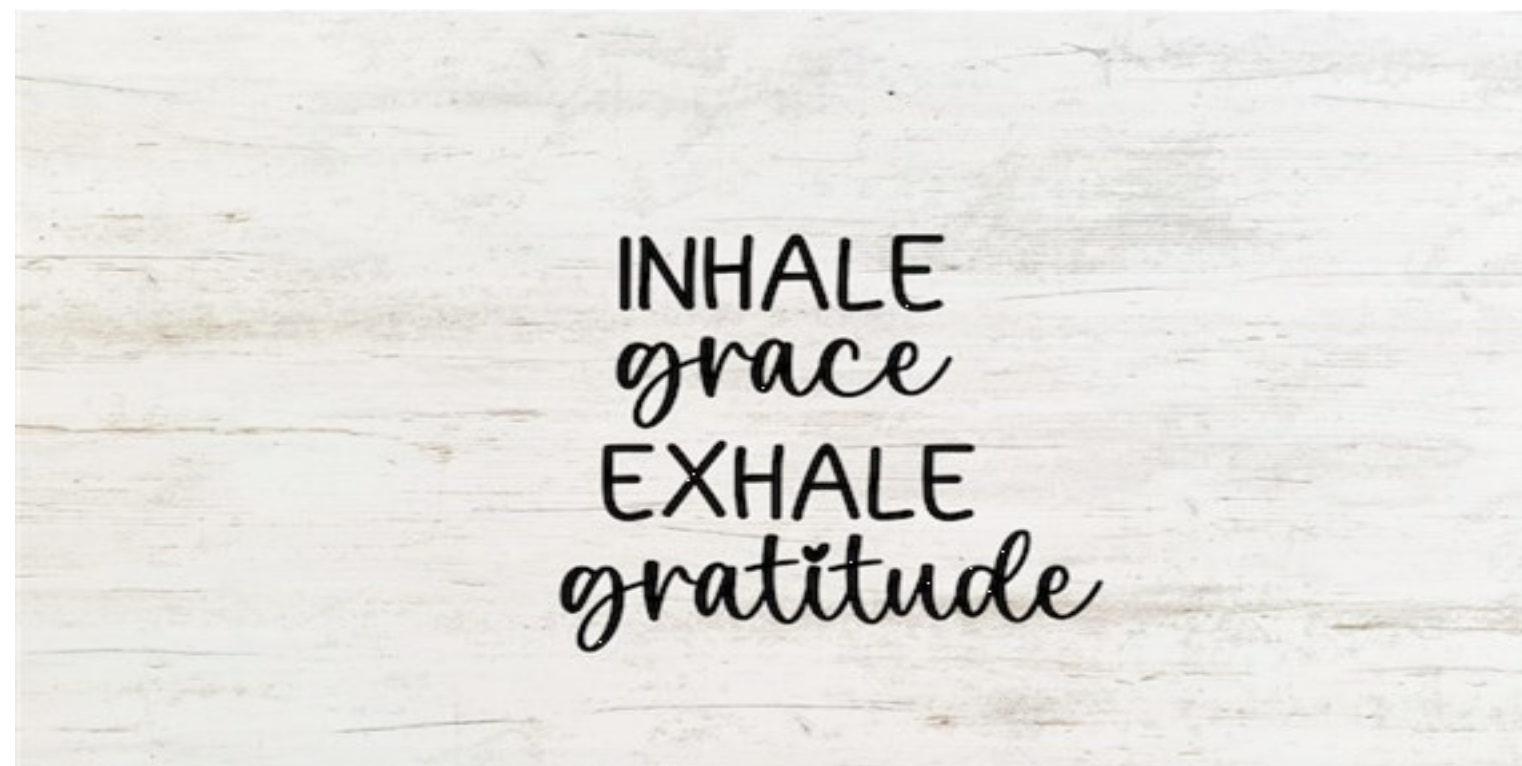

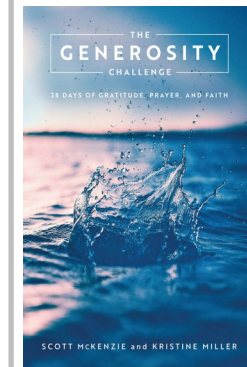
This is your mission, if you choose to accept it:
